Sunday, 9<sup>th</sup>. King tide. Monday & Tuesday: plays in the school. Wednesday: a cinematograph entertainment, generously provided by Dean Dolan.

16<sup>th</sup>. Holy Name. The feast as usual. We sang all the Proper of the Mass. gradual etc & Offertory were not a great success as many of the nuns had colds.
