We are preparing for the six yearly General Chapter of our Association which will take place near Bruges in the first half of August.


The theme is a very fruitful one - Women of the dawn - at the crossroads of time embracing the world with hope.

LISTENING TO GOD WITH BISHOP GULI FRANCIS-DEHQANI






We were thrilled to have Bishop Guli Francis-Dehqani (Anglican Bishop of Chelmsford) as part of our year's theme of 'Listening'.
